1.13 (b) \$500,000 each year is for the Minnesota Children's Museum.

1.14 (c) \$50,000 each year is for the Children's Museum of Rochester.

1.15 (d) \$41,000 ~~each year is~~ in fiscal year 2024 and \$125,000 in fiscal year 2025 are for the
1.16 Minnesota Academy of Science.

1.17 (e) \$100,000 each year is for The Bakken Museum, Minneapolis.

1.18 (f) \$50,000 each year is for the Headwaters Science Center.

1.19 (g) \$50,000 each year is for The Works Museum, Bloomington.

1.20 (h) \$50,000 each year is for the WonderTrek Children's Museum, Brainerd-Baxter.

1.21 (i) \$50,000 each year is for the Otter Cove Children's Museum, Fergus Falls.

- 2.1 (j) \$50,000 each year is for the Children's Discovery Museum, Grand Rapids.
- 2.2 (k) \$50,000 each year is for the Wheel and Cog Children's Museum, Hutchinson.
- 2.3 (l) \$50,000 each year is for the Village Children's Museum, Willmar.
- 2.4 (m) \$50,000 each year is for the Duluth Children's Museum, Duluth.
- 2.5 (n) \$50,000 each year is for the Children's Museum of Southern Minnesota, Mankato.
- 2.6 (o) \$50,000 each year is for the Great River Children's Museum, St. Cloud.
- 2.7 (p) \$50,000 each year is for the Children's Discovery Museum, Breckenridge.
- 2.8 (q) A recipient of a grant under this subdivision must use the funds to encourage and
2.9 increase access for historically underserved communities.
- 2.10 (r) Up to three percent of the appropriation is available for grant administration.
- 2.11 (s) Any balance in the first year does not cancel but is available in the second year.
- 2.12 (t) The base for fiscal year 2026 and later is ~~\$1,791,000~~ \$1,875,000. Of this amount,
2.13 ~~\$691,000~~ \$775,000 is for the museums and amounts indicated for fiscal year 2025 in
2.14 paragraphs (b) to (e), \$60,000 is for the museum in paragraph (f), \$600,000 is for the
2.15 museums in paragraphs (g) to (l) in the amount of \$100,000 per museum, and \$440,000 is
2.16 for the museums in paragraphs (m) to (p) in the amount of \$110,000 per museum.
